heavenly throngs.

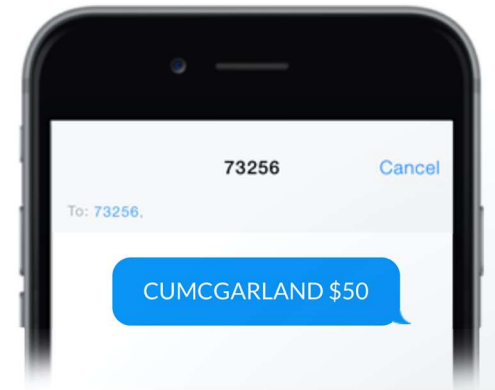
